

**As per Procurement Guidelines and Tender Document of (SMART)Project:**

**1)Tender Fee & Bid Security:**

**a) Tender Fee:**

It is mandatory for the bidder to submit tender fee online on <https://mahatenders.gov.in>

**b) Bid Security:**

1. Bidder should submit bid security (EMD) in the form of bid security declaration in the attached format. If bidder not submitted bid security declaration, the bid submitted by such bidder shall be rejected.
2. The Bid Security declaration shall be executed
  - a) if a bidder withdraws its bid prior to the expiry date of bid validity specified by the bidder on the letter of bid or any extended date provided by the bidder; or
  - b) any information submitted found manipulated / hidden /false / mala fide in the bid
  - c) if the successful Bidder fails to
    - (i) Sign the Contract or
    - (ii) Furnish a Performance Security

**2)Bid Validity Period:**

Bid shall remain valid for a period not less than 120 days after the deadline date specified for submission of bid.

**3)Payment Terms-**

- (i) **On Delivery:** 50% of the Contract Price shall be paid on receipt of the Goods and upon submission of the documents specified in GCC Clause 13.
- (ii) **On Acceptance/ installation:** 40% of the Contract Price shall be paid within thirty (30) days after receipt of tax invoice along with acceptance certificate issued by the purchaser's appointed authority.
- (iii) Remaining 10% of the Contract Price will be paid after 3 months from the date of installation & commissioning and upon satisfactory performance of the goods.


**4)Warranty Terms -**

The period of validity of the Warranty shall be 60 Months and 5 years AMC from the date of commissioning.

For purposes of the Warranty, the place(s) of final destination(s) shall be: location of project

The Supplier shall, in addition, comply with the performance and/or consumption guarantees specified under the Contract. If, for reasons attributable to the Supplier, these guarantees are not attained in whole or in part, the Supplier shall, at its discretion, either:

- (a) make such changes, modifications, and/or additions to the Goods or any part thereof as may be necessary in order to attain the contractual guarantees specified in the Contract at its own cost and expense and to carry out further performance tests in accordance with GCC 26.7
- or
- (b) pay liquidated damages to the Purchaser with respect to the failure to meet the contractual guarantees. The rate of these liquidated damages shall be 0.5 % per week.
