ICAR – NRRI, Cuttack organized training programme on “Advanced Rice Production Technologies & Value addition”

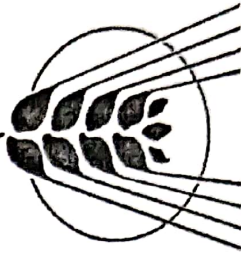
The ICAR- National Rice Research Institute, Cuttack organized a training programme on “Advanced Rice Production Technologies & value addition in association with Rural Access Private Limited for 30 farmers and 2 Agricultural Officers from Chandrapur district of Maharashtra during 25th -31st March, 2025. The programme was sponsored by Head DIU SMART, Chandrapur. The training programme commenced with an inaugural session chaired by Dr. A. K. Nayak, Director, NRRI on 25th March, 2025. The Director in his inaugural address enlightened the participants about the importance of the training and inspired them to adopt new technologies to gain more profit. Dr. A.K. Nayak discussed various facets of rice farming with all the participants. They showed their interest in post-harvest processing and value addition of rice and vegetables. During the discussion, Director advised all the scientists to work on developing storage structures to improve the shelf-life of vegetables such as potatoes and onions. Improving the shelf life of vegetables is an important aspect of post-harvest processing because it helps reduce food wastage and ensures a more stable food supply. The farmers were exposed to different innovative and recent technologies in rice production, advanced implements, and IFS model, which were highly appreciated by them. The sessions were prepared keeping in view the land situation, and the need and availability of resources of the participants, so they found it suitable and interesting. The programme ended with a valedictory function, certificate distribution. Dr Gyatri Sinha, Sr. Scientist, SSD was the Course Director of the programme.


