

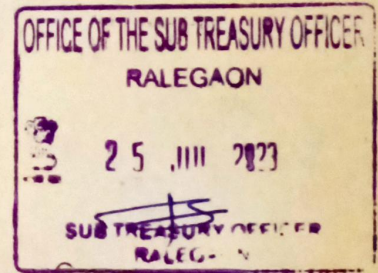

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

Arya Collateral warehousing service private Limited H 82, Ground Floor

AND

JIVNOTI MAHILA PRODUCER COMPANY LTD., RALEGAON, YAVATMAL

Arya Collateral Warehousing Services Private Limited (ARYA) is India's leading Agritech start-up with a focus on integrated post-harvest services. Driving technology through a human-centered approach, Arya's Agritech and Fintech platform leverages technology to bridge the last Mile. It efficiently connects the supply side of the Agri ecosystem with the demand side. Arya assists sellers of agri-commodities to avoid distress sale of produce by extending post-harvest credit. It's integrated and easy-to-use platform also helps users to choose ancillary services like warehouse management, access to finance, quality testing, storage protection services, and connects produce to buyer through a robust technology-enabled back end ecosystem.

ARYA is headquartered in Noida, Uttar Pradesh, India, with presence in 20 states of India.

ARYA and JIVNOTI MAHILA PRODUCER COMPANY LTD. RALEGAON YAVATMAL desire and intend to develop co-operation and collaboration in space of Community Based Organizations (CBOs) and their value chains with a special focus on technology enabled services for post-harvest ecosystem.

- 1.1. To jointly identify opportunities for FPO institution where Arya or its subsidiaries can extend services such as warehouse receipt finance, procurement finance, facilitation of marketing of produce and collateral management services.
- 1.2. To collaborate in initiating and improving of technology enabled services for small holders which can serve as use cases for large scale implementations in similar conditions.
- 1.3. To collaborate in activities and projects in space of livelihood opportunities for CBOs under mutual agreement.
- 1.4. To develop within the limitations of the Institution's resources, policies and procedures, collaborative work plans that specify the activities to be undertaken, objectives and targets, implementation mechanisms, roles and responsibilities, and resource contributions.
- 1.5. To jointly seek funding, grants in partnership or in collaboration with other mutually agreed entities for study and implementation of tech enabled value chain interventions for the benefit of ecosystem.
- 1.6. To share, within the limitations of the Institutions' resources, policies and procedures, and knowledge resources of both institutions after due approvals by required focal points at both institutions.




- 1.7. To impart capability building training and mentoring to FPO on a purely voluntary basis and subject to required institutional Material Transfer Agreements.


This document is not intended to create legal or binding obligations on either party. It serves only as a record of the parties' current intentions. Before any of the activities set out in this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) are implemented, to ensure the activities can be accomplished in conformity with the law and to enable the principles set out in this MoU to be implemented, the Institutions shall enter a formal documented communication with each other which shall detail the specific form and content of the activities and cover the responsibilities and rights of each Institution. Such agreements shall be negotiated in good faith.

3. This MoU commences from the date of last signing and shall be in force for 3 (three) years. The MoU may be terminated at any time by mutual consent or by 3 months' notice by either party. It may be amended, modified, extended, or renewed only by the written consent of both Parties. The Institutions agree to review this MoU 6 (six) months prior to end of the 3-year term.

4. The specific terms of this MoU do not preclude the development of future collaborative ventures or projects not mentioned in this document.
