4. **IPDA:** As part of the Institutional Development Plan (IDP), the development of a digital presence was identified as a foundational step toward enhancing IPDA's visibility, stakeholder engagement, and knowledge dissemination. To ensure the website's relevance and user-centric design, a Website Discussion Meeting was held on 4th

July 2025 with the development team from GeeCom India Pvt. Ltd. During this session, the TSP and the vendor discussed the site's layout, content architecture, and visual identity. The website is being developed to reflect IPDA's mission, showcase its activities, and provide stakeholders with timely access to sectoral insights and resources.

In parallel, IPDA has established a presence on LinkedIn, where regular updates are shared on its initiatives, including participation in national and international events, webinars, and sectoral seminars. Additionally, the creation of an official email ID (publicrelations@ipda.in) has streamlined communication and enhanced professional outreach. Looking ahead, IPDA envisions evolving this website into a comprehensive digital platform in the subsequent phase of the IDP. This platform will go beyond static information sharing to offer interactive features such as real-time market intelligence dashboards, subscription-based content, virtual training modules, and collaborative tools for members. The long-term goal is to create a robust, data-driven ecosystem that empowers stakeholders across the pulses value chain with actionable insights, policy engagement opportunities, and digital services tailored to their needs.

The secondary data were collected, and the study period has been divided into two sub-periods i.e. period I (2001-02 to 2010-11) and period II (2011-12 to 2021-22) and the overall period (2001-02 to 2021-22) to assess the performance of major fruits i.e. mango and citrus. The analysis employed compound growth rates and instability indices, including the Coefficient of Variation (CV) and Cuddy Della Valle's Instability Index (CDVII), to evaluate the trends and fluctuations in the area, production, and productivity of major fruits. The results revealed that citrus exhibited significant growth in area during period I, but this trend reversed in period II, leading to a marginal overall decrease. Conversely, citrus production improved significantly in period II, despite initial declines, indicating favorable conditions or interventions that enhanced productivity. Mango showed a substantial expansion in area during period I, followed by a sharp decline in period II, leading to an overall decrease. Both</p> <p>fruits displayed considerable instability, particularly in production and productivity, with mango exhibiting more pronounced fluctuations across the study period. The findings highlighted the need for targeted interventions to address the underlying challenges and stabilize the performance of these major fruits in Maharashtra. The study underscored the importance of enhancing productivity while managing the variability and instability in the agricultural sector to ensure sustainable growth and economic stability for farmers in the region.</p>
